ARIZONA'S 2001 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN**


WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Camp Verde through the Marshal's Office is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration;

**NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That approval of the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2001 Highway Safety Plan is granted.
2. That Marshal John Wischmeyer is appointed agent for the Town of Camp Verde to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.


