A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE, YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA, TO APPLY FOR THE COPS IN SCHOOLS 2001 GRANT


WHEREAS, through the program the U.S. Department of Justice has established the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) to expedite the hiring of new police officers and to implement community policing programs, and


WHEREAS, the Camp Verde Marshal's Office has completed a grant application under the COPS in schools 2001 program to fund a school resources officer in the amount of \$114,659.51 to include salary and benefits for 3 years, with the Town being required to retain the position for at least one locally funded budget cycle after the grant ends, and


WHEREAS, upon approval by the Town, the grant application will be submitted to the Board of the Camp Verde Unified School District as a partner in the program,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMP VERDE RESOLVE TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION UNDER THE COPS IN SCHOOLS 2001 PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXECUTION BY THE TOWN MARSHAL AND MAYOR.
